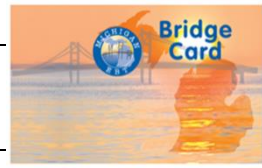




2023 Garden Starters Order Form

- When:** Saturday, May 20th from 11:30 AM - 5:00 PM
- Where:** Neighborhood Engagement Hub - 3216 M.L. King Ave. Flint, MI 48505
(Travel north on M.L. King Ave, turn right on Pasadena Ave, and then turn right on Essex St)
- Pick Up:** You can get your purchases as a drive-through with kits and compost being placed in your trunk or backseat. Or if you prefer, you may park and visit the various booths that we have set up for the day.
- Swap Table:** This table is for those interested in swapping any of their plants or seeds. Eggplant, rosemary, okra, and collard plants will be available at this table. Small garden items will also be for sale.
- Raffle:** Tickets can still be purchased. The raffle drawing will be at 5:00 PM on Distribution Day.
